#### HB 1469 - Magazine Ban

Bans the sale, purchase, transfer or possession of any magazine over 10 rounds and use of body armor (applies to all gun owners; even retired law enforcement or veterans).

### HB 772 - No Due Process for Gun Owners

Creates the Lethal Order Protection Act that would allow family members, ex-spouses, and even former girlfriends/boyfriends to petition the courts to have an individual labeled a "danger to oneself or others" just for owning a firearm. Also, firearms would be seized without due process and require the individual to cover all legal fees to get seized property back and clear his or her name.

HB 1465 Increases age to 21 to possess or purchase a rifle.

### **HB 1468**

Increases waiting period on rifles to 72 hours.

#### SB 2314

Grants municipalities authority to regulate possession and ownership of semi-auto rifles.

#### SB 3297

SEMI-AUTO RIFLE BAN, .50 caliber firearm, and magazines of more than 10 rounds.
